## **SEK-CAP ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR RENTAL ASSISTANCE STARTING MAY 14TH**

Girard, KS –The Southeast Kansas Community Action Program (SEK-CAP), will begin accepting applications for the Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher Program on May 14<sup>th</sup>, 2018 and will continue to accept them until further notice.

The Section 8 HCV Program assists qualifying individuals and families with rental subsidies based on household income. To potentially qualify for assistance, an applicant's income must fall below the HUD Section 8 rental assistance program guidelines, which is 50% of the Area Median Income (AMI). The income guidelines vary by county and are based on family size. Income guidelines can be reviewed on the SEK-CAP website, [www.sek-cap.com](http://www.sek-cap.com).
