**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Southeast Kansas Community Action Program (SEK-CAP) will hold a Public Hearing to accept public comments regarding proposed updates to the SEK-CAP Public Housing Authority (PHA) Administrative Plan on Wednesday, August 21st, 2019 at 1:30pm.
